

The list below includes a few examples (really, just a few-it's amazing how many there really are) of creativity and "community" exhibited by people, organizations or businesses to help everyone get through the last 10 months. I am sure each of you can think of a new idea or inspiring story you have heard of.

### Some inspiring stories of creativity and community during the last 10 months:

- ➤ **John Krasinski Hosts Some Good News:** It feels like forever ago, but John Krasinski hosted a news show from his home that was all about good news! It was refreshing, fun and what we all needed. One of the highlights was him hosting a virtual prom with the Jonas Brothers and Billie Eilish.
- **Domino's Pizza:** Domino's created a contest in the form of a film festival encouraging people to create homemade videos. The winner receives a year's worth of pizza and could be featured in future commercials!
- Invisible Hands: This non-profit in the New York/Tri-State Area has a mission of delivering groceries and other essential items to vulnerable populations. The group is made up of volunteers, which encourages neighbors to help out neighbors!
- ➤ Elisha Nochomovitz: When the Barcelona Marathon got cancelled, Elisha decided to still run it on his balcony that was about 23 feet long. While it wasn't the streets of Barcelona, 3,000 laps later he accomplished a marathon! There were a lot of stories like Elisha's of people setting out to accomplish goals when their original plans had been changed.
- > Spotify: A lot of us use Spotify and a lot of us use it for free. We do that because they depend on advertising to keep them going. When that came to a stop, Spotify began creating its own content in the form of original podcasts and celebrity curated playlists. Guess what? It worked!
- ➤ Various Restaurants Make Pivots: Lots of restaurants have made significant pivots since having to stop or limit the number of indoor diners. Some examples include: hosting cooking and baking classes, creating meal kits for families to take home, and cooking kits that can be shipped nationwide.

Seeing people show up for each other; the sense of community and creative spirit demonstrated in the examples above has been inspiring for me in so many ways. But as a member of the Wico community, it is nothing new. At camp we are creative. At camp we try new things. At camp we have people who support us. At camp we support other people. we can add you to the 2021 Big Sister list. Priority is given to those who signed up and were not matched up in 2020. We will do our best to match up as many Bigs as possible!






# Tooth Losing Competition




